This is no, no, no.



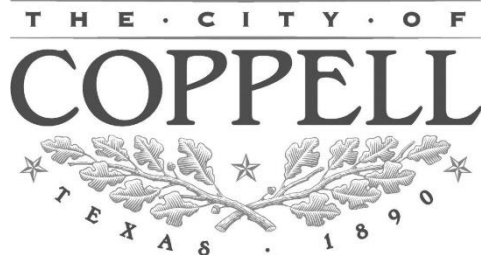
I Take My Little Hands

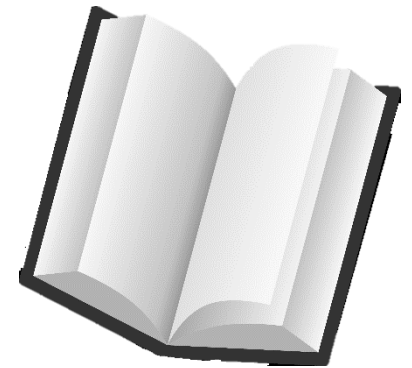

Good morning to you.



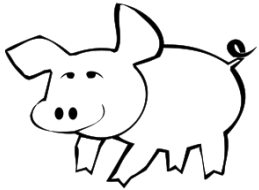
The More We Get Together

This Little Piggy

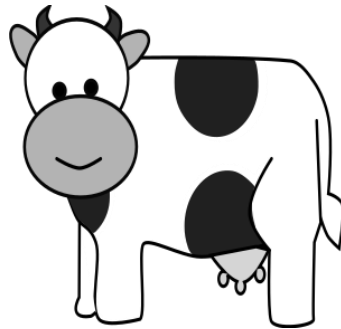


This little piggy went to market.
